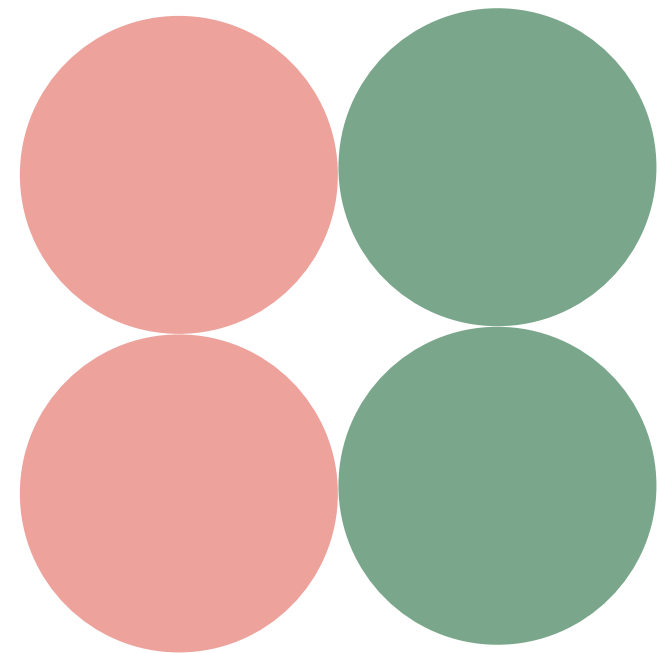
Project Summary

The project aim to foster a change in the behavior of fathers in order to give women the opportunity to reconcile motherhood and work Childcare and family management are almost always the sole responsibility of women mothers.

The aim is therefore to raise awareness among fathers and understand their importance of their role in this area so as to rebalance the tasks and responsibilities within the family on both parents

The awareness of fathers will take place through a series of training activities 1 mobility in Finland, a country that gives great importance to the issue, where it will be possible to share the experiences of Finnish fathers 2 to understand the needs of the woman mother in the period from pre to post childbirth 3 aimed at making the father understand how to manage the needs of children in the first years of life in order to be personally responsible for them 4 final project evaluation.

All expenses will be paid in advance by the participants.

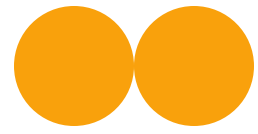
The coordinator will reimburse the costs by bank transfer after the delivery of the supporting documentation.

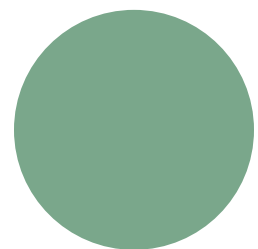

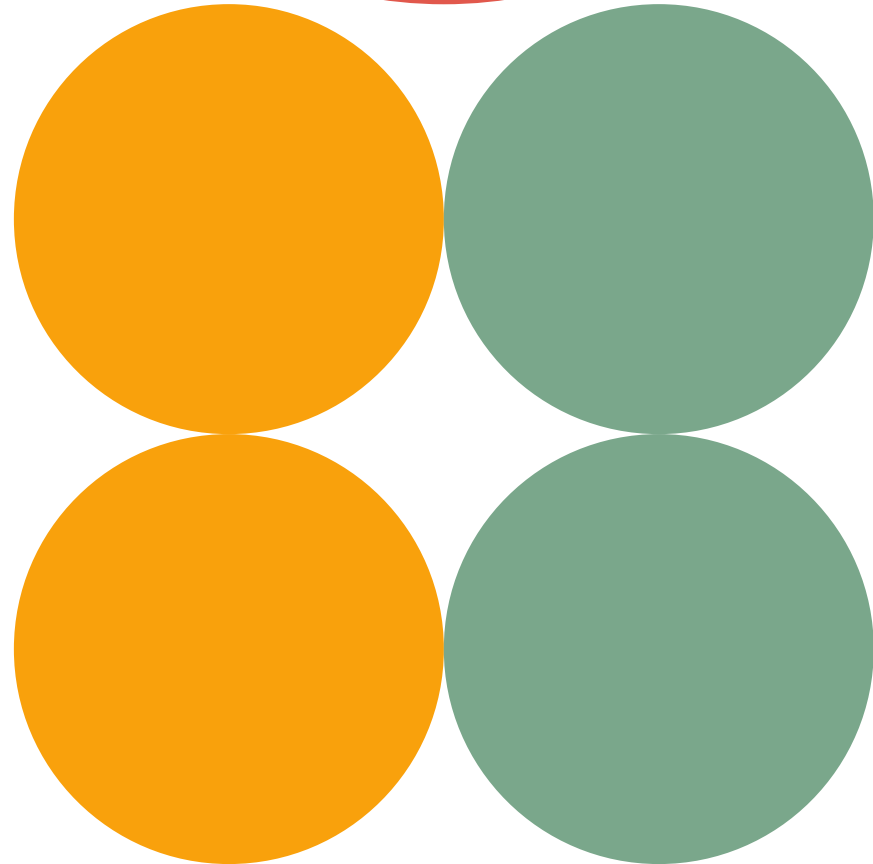
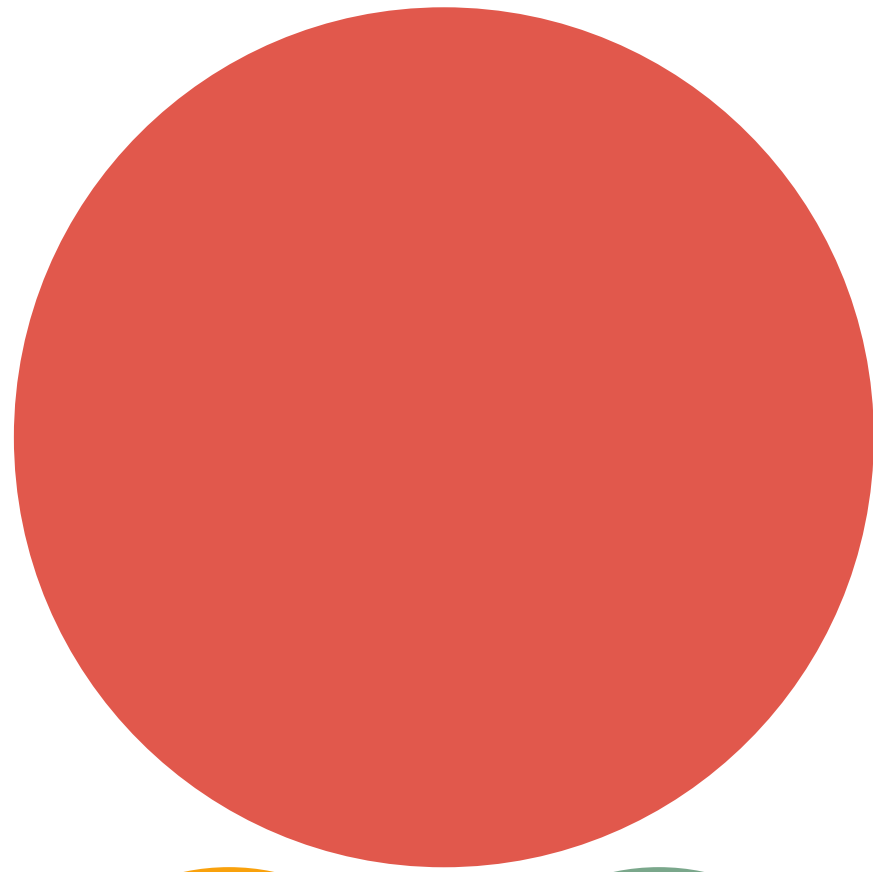
To be considered eligible, these costs must be reasonable, conform to local prices and be exclusively linked to the project. Lost, fake or incomplete documentation will not be reimbursed.
