

About the Training Course

When designing the accreditation this project is a part of, we took into consideration as the main problem:



"Social exclusion of young people and disintegration in the labor market as a consequence of the absence of key competencies for lifelong learning and entrepreneurial thinking and attitudes."

In addition to the challenges underlying youth's personal, educational and professional change, young people face added challenges and needs that, without the proper support and opportunities, end up being detrimental to the construction of their future and life project.

The relational gap between young people and their environment hinders their work. If they are not able to identify and promote participative actions, appealing and adjusted to the needs and interests of young people, young talent and potential will continue to be wasted.

Digital competences and skills are essential to give every individual an equal opportunity to thrive in life, find employment and be an engaged citizen. Having digital competences and skills and ensuring the availability of digital infrastructure and equipment has become even more crucial since the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Nearly all future learning and jobs will require a certain level of digital competences and skills. The ongoing technological evolution demands the lifelong development of competences and skills by all learners if Europe is to remain economically competitive and participate in social life.

This Training Course aims to create a network of well-trained youth workers (YWs) ready to guide and support young people in the digital world, enabling them to make the most of opportunities and contribute to social innovation, economic growth, and sustainable development.

Besides this, *Back to the Digital Era* works towards guaranteeing gender equality for all participants, responding to the Youth Goal 2, determined by the EU Youth Strategy, which encompasses the "equal access to formal and non-formal education."

AIMS

- Empower YWs with up-to-date information on digital entrepreneurship trends, technologies, and opportunities.
- Empower YWs to teach and mentor young people in practical aspects, such as supporting the development of start-up projects on Digital Entrepreneurship and adapting existing projects to the digital revolution.
- Encourage YWs to foster creativity and innovation in young people, helping them identify innovative and disruptive solutions to the challenges of the digital world.
- Foster the sharing of digital tools and platforms relevant to entrepreneurship, such as project management systems.
- Provide YWs with new methodologies for mentoring young people in leadership, team management, and strategic planning, which is essential for entrepreneurial success in the digital context.

- Prepare YWs to deal with the unique challenges young people face in the digital world, such as the rapid evolution of technology, online competition, and cyber security.
- Empower YWs to become more experienced mentors and facilitators, able to support young people on their journey effectively.

Guimarães is considered the birthplace of Portugal because the first king of Portugal, Afonso Henriques, was born there.

Associated with the Portuguese identity, the historic center of Guimarães, in the area inside the walls, was classified as a World Heritage Site by Unesco based on the values of originality and authenticity with which it was recovered.

From Guimarães, cities as Porto and Braga are easily reached.

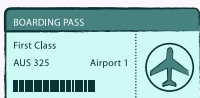
Computer or another working device
